Ramblings From the Rectory

Remembrance Sunday will soon be upon us. This year we welcome Bishop Graham James who will be conducting the Pelynt Remembrance Sunday Service. Graham is the retired Bishop of Norwich and lives in Cornwall.

Most families have special people they will remember at this time. It's a very poignant time for me as my great grandfather was killed in the trenches in World War One. He saw the futility of the war and at first refused to sign up. He was a family man committed to his 3 young daughters, Marjory (6), Phyllis (4) my grandmother and Edith (2). White feathers were posted through his letter box as a sign of cowardice. My great grandfather was certainly no coward but his heart was touched and so he signed up as a matter of duty. Within two weeks of arriving on the Somme news came home that he had been killed in action. His three precious daughters had lost their beloved Daddy and his wife her husband. My grandmother remembers the austerity of those war years living on hand outs and having to go over on Saturday to sign on, as it was, at the local police station so that an early form of social security was provided.

The story has a somewhat happy ending as my great grandmother met Richard Hanks, who I am named after, towards the end of the war and he became a much loved and treasured step Dad to these three little girls. All of us will remember with pride family stories like mine.

We will of course remember and pray for all those who have lost lives and are affected by the war in Ukraine and pray that an act of God may take place and peaceful settlement achieved in this needless and futile conflict.

May I take this opportunity to wish you and your family a very happy and blessed Christmas and hope to see you at one of our Christmas services.
